Project Brief

There are a number of local community sport and leisure clubs in and around the Totnes area but do many young people use them regularly and have them as part of a healthy and active lifestyle. For this project your challenge is in three parts;

Part 1: is to find out about these local community sport and leisure clubs and design a poster that will advertise all of them to students your age.

Part 2: is to conduct your own experiment by taking part in at least one of these clubs to experience first hand what impact it has on your life

Part 3: is to review part 2 and write a piece for our school magazine about your experience

Learning Skill(s) developed

Final project format

A **poster** to reflect what is in our local community that other students of your age can take part in and this could include drawings, logos, maps, etc. A piece of **extended writing** that shows clear evaluation of the impact of participating in at least one of the clubs which could include persuasive writing to encourage others to join up.
