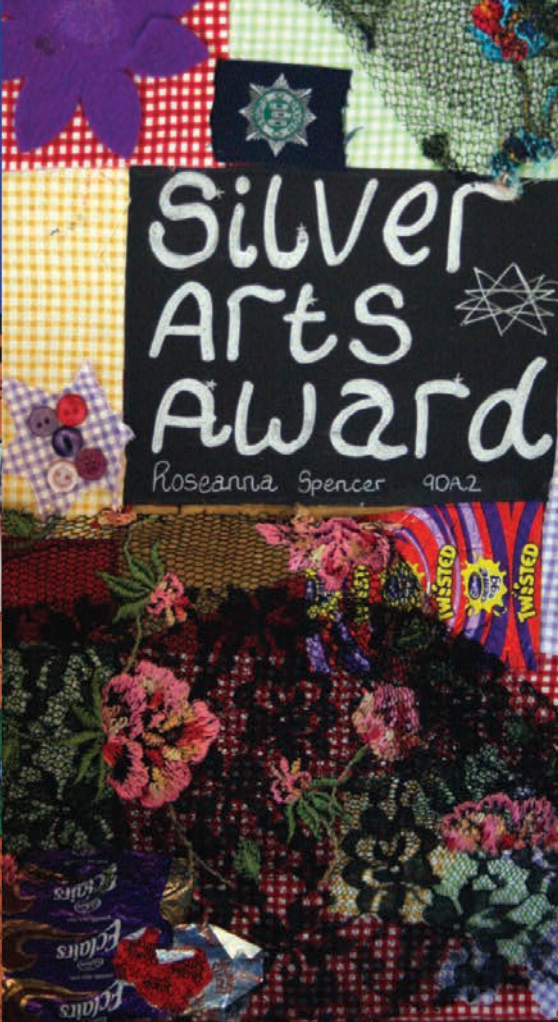

## New achievements for KEVICC

KEVICC is hugely proud to have been awarded Arts Award Good Practice Centre status for 2013/14; one of only six nationally. KEVICC is also able to run the Arts Award at Gold level through a successful tender to RIO (an Arts Council England Bridge Organisation for the South West)
