SUCCESS . . .



This year's exam results at GCSE and A level build even further on last year's record breaking achievement of students.

Kennicott Sixth Form Centre at King Edward VI Community College is celebrating yet another impressive performance in A and AS level results, as well as a string of excellent results across a range of other courses. Overall, KEVICC students were entered for 386 A levels with an astonishing 100% pass rate and 50% of all A level grades awarded at the top grades: A*, A and B!

A level scientists at Kennicott have much to celebrate with 86% of Physics results at the highest grades, 63% of Chemistry results and 48% of Biology results. Mathematicians can boast even greater success with 100% of grades at A*-B at A level.

At both A and AS level, students have delivered striking performances in Art, Photography and Textiles securing not only a 100% pass rate but 71% of students achieving A*-B in Art A level, 70% in Photography and 100% in Textiles.

The GCSE results also reflect an upward trend with the percentage of students gaining five of the top A*-C grades including English and mathematics rising to 65%. The percentage of students gaining 5 A*-C is sustained at 77%.
