Students achieve well Ofsted acknowledges the improvements in students' attainment at both GCSE and A Level over the past three years. In particular, Ofsted inspectors note that in English and Maths 'the proportion of students making or exceeding the progress expected of them in Years 7 to 11 is greater than the national average'.

Ofsted singled out the 'notably high' achievement of students in mathematics, physics, chemistry, art and design and religious studies where 'the highest grades A* and A are above average'.
