BTEC Art Induction Task 2019

We would like you to demonstrate potential in the key areas by which you will be judged. These are :

Develop their ideas through sustained and focused investigations informed by contextual and other sources, demonstrating analytical and critical understanding.

Experiment with and select appropriate resources, media, materials, techniques and processes, reviewing and refining their ideas as their work develops.

Record in visual and/or other forms ideas, observations and insights relevant to their intentions, demonstrating an ability to reflect on their work and progress

Present a personal, informed and meaningful response demonstrating critical understanding, realising intentions and, where appropriate, making connections between visual, written, oral or other elements.

Evaluating your work against your intentions and suggesting improvements for the future

1. Find a reproduction of a famous work of Art that provokes a strong response in you. Write about its context, the artist and what you think about it.
2. Make an observational drawing of an object, figure or place “related” to this work.
3. Develop 1. and 2. by making a further practical response to your chosen work. This could be a painting, sculpture, print or textiles piece.
4. Evaluate your response and explain how you have made connections to your chosen artist and how you could develop this idea further.
