#### **School Provision**

Families will be aware we are offering face to face sessions for keyworker, SEND, Y10 and Y12 students, following strict social distancing guidelines in school.

This will bring all of our communications onto one app, and will include the facility to contact teachers directly, make payments, check students' attendance and timetables - amongst others. Please be patient with us over the coming weeks as we set up this functionality on the system. As elements of the app come on stream, you will receive updates and notifications.

### <u>Uniform</u>

Please see attached a separate letter regarding an amendment to uniform from September 2020. This has been put in place to ensure our uniform is as cost effective as possible for families, whilst remaining smart and practical.
