



KEVICC LEARNING AGREEMENT

The Learning Agreement recognises the importance of collaboration between students, parents and the College in order to support success and allow students to fulfil their potential. All policies referred to are found on the College Website in the About Us section. **We have three key expectations of our students; to be ready, respectful and safe.**

Students

I will:

BE READY

- Attend College, be punctual to all my lessons and have everything I need for learning.
- Dress correctly in college uniform and learn to the best of my ability in every lesson.
- Meet all coursework, homework and classwork deadlines

BE RESPECTFUL

- Treat everyone (staff and students) with respect.
- Always be a good representative of the College, including during the journey to and from College and ensure I treat the College site with respect.
- Follow the 'Behaviour for Learning Policy' and high expectations of the College

BE SAFE

- Talk to my Tutor, head of house or another teacher if I have any worries or concerns about me or another student.
- Report concerns about visitors, facilities or online safety to a member of school staff.

Parents/Carers

I/We will:

BE READY

- Support my/our child's progress by looking through work, checking class charts and Weduc information and discussing assessments, reports and targets regularly.
- Ensure my/our child attends College, is punctual and notify the College (by 9.30am on the day of absence) the reason for his/her absence.
- Support Home Learning
- Avoid taking holidays in term time as absence affects learning.
- Attend Parents' Evenings (Consultation Meetings) and take up other opportunities to discuss progress.

BE RESPECTFUL

- Support the College's policies in all aspects.
- Communicate appropriately with staff regarding any concerns through the school's *official channels*, and not social media, so they can be dealt with in line with the school's complaints procedure.
- Ensure my/our child follows the Behaviour for Learning Policy which we have read and support the college in ensuring students are held to the highest expectations.

BE SAFE

- Notify the Tutor, head of house or relevant teacher of any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's learning and wellbeing.
- Observe all visitor and site safety requirements when visiting the college site

We will:

BE READY

- Encourage students to maintain high expectations of work and behaviour, in order to ensure they reach their full potential, through stimulating and inspiring learning experiences.
- Ensure home learning is set and marked to enhance student learning.
- Keep parents and students informed of College activities and student progress through the College Reporting System, College website, letters home, Weduc and Class charts.

BE RESPECTFUL

- Demonstrate mutual respect, support and develop all students in our care demonstrating calm and consistent adult behaviour.
- Meet and greet our students at the start of each lesson.
- Pay first attention to best conduct of young people.

BE SAFE

- Contact parents as soon as possible with any concerns or problems about their child's wellbeing.
- Follow the staff code of conduct and Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy and uphold the national teacher standards.
