Dear Parent or Carer, and Student,

Y12 Learning: Online 19-21 July

Some of you may already be aware that this week we have had two confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Y12.

We have taken advice from the local authority and their public health team, and we have taken into account;

- These 2 positive cases
- 27 Y12 students who are currently self-isolating as they have been close contacts of confirmed cases
- Staff absence owing to self-isolation

In light of this, we have made the difficult decision to move all Y12 lessons from Monday P1 online for the remainder of the summer term.

This means that Y12 students should not attend College next week, but should attend lessons via google meets online in accordance with their usual timetable.

This decision has not been taken lightly. However, with staff and student absence in this year group, we feel it offers the safest and best decision.

Should students need to attend College to collect any exercise books or materials they need, they will be allowed to do so P1 on Monday, and they are asked to be off the College site by 1000.

We are sorry for the premature end to their academic year. This group have worked really hard in difficult circumstances this year.

Thank you again for the support you are showing to your young people, our school and our community at this time.
