Dear Parent and Carer,

I hope this update finds you well and enjoying some real summer weather at last! Thank you to those of you who have been in touch with feedback following last week's update and the Q and A session. We have had some lovely comments, especially around the new school sweatshirts and hoodies (more below!). Here are a few important points to consider:

1. Bridge Removal- Drop off and Pick Up

Devon County Council have identified that the footbridge over the main A385 outside the school that crosses to the Elmhirst Site is in need of repair. As such, they have road closures and removal work planned to start from Monday 11 July (next week).

The entire bridge is being dismantled and taken away for much needed repairs over the Summer. We are working with Devon County Council to prevent any impact on our students, and to minimise disruption to parents and carers.

Please note:

- car parking on the Elmhirst Site will be significantly reduced from Monday (11th July) as DCC will • require space for heavy machinery.
- Please be extra careful when dropping off and picking up students, as it is likely to be busier at these times.
- Please consider alternative arrangements if you can for pick up in the afternoons- and please be mindful of local residents and our community if picking up from other locations.
- Please note the Elmhirst car park will be completely closed from 5pm each day for the period while • the contractors are on site.
- We have sent a separate message to users of the All-Weather Pitch outlining parking arrangements • for their clubs during this period

Of course, the safety of students will be our priority, and a temporary traffic light crossing is being installed by DCC to enable students to cross safely to lessons on Elmhirst. As usual, staff will be on duty at the start and end of the day to help ensure student safety.

2. Sports Day 2022

Next Thursday 14th July is our Sports Day, and we can't wait! Please make sure students have sun hats, sun cream and a bottle for drinking water, as the forecast is hot and sunny. We will make sure there is plenty of shade and water. Those students taking part in events can come to school in their PE kit on Thursday, and students are encouraged to wear a top in the colour of their house if they wish.
