Dear Parent and Carer,

It's hard to believe it has been only a four day week, let alone that we are only a little over a fortnight into term, given how busy life around the College has been. Here are a few updates to note:

1. My Child at School App

Thank you all so much for your patience around recent changes to the school IT systems. Whereas we know it hasn't been as smooth a transition as it might have been, it is great to now see the majority of parents and increasing numbers of students able to log on to the My Child at School app.

Once all the teething issues are ironed out, we do feel we will be one step nearer to what we have been trying to move towards for a while, which is one integrated system that gives parents and carers the ability to see all the information they need in one place and to provide a one stop shop for all manner of admin, such as payments, consent forms and the like.

We are continuing to use Weduc for payments in the medium term, but by the end of the year we hope to be able to transfer this to My Child at School as well. At this stage we will be that final step nearer to having everything in one place!

Our IT team are continuing to work hard to support students with logons and troubleshooting. Please remind students that their email addresses follow the format below:

Students at KEVICC before September 2022

Last two digits of the year their cohort would have started at KEVICC/Initial First Name/Surname @kingedwardvi.org.uk

e.g a student in Y10 would be 19ASalt@kingedwardvi.org.uk as their cohort started Y7 in 2019

Students joining KEVICC from September 2022

Last two digits of the year their cohort would have started at KEVICC/First 5 letters of surname/Initial First Name

e.g a student in Y7 would be 22SaltA@kingedwardvi.org.uk and a student joining KEVICC from another school in September 2022 would be 19SaltA@kingededwardvi.org.uk

2. Ashburton Road Footbridge

We are continuing to have updates from Devon County Council about when we can expect the refurbished footbridge to be reinstalled.

















It now looks like the work will begin the middle of next week. It will include two or three night-time closures of the Ashburton Road, but we have been assured this will be well after school hours at 7pm.

3. Open Evenings and Open Mornings

As planning for the Y7 residential reaches a peak, it's been great to see more trips and visits in the pipeline and at the planning stage.
