Dear Parent or Carer,

I hope this short update finds you well, and that you are looking forward to what looks like a sunny bank holiday weekend and half term break.

It seems to have been a busy term as ever - losing those days to bank holidays and industrial action has left us with the same amount to do in even less time! As ever, it has been great to see how students and staff continue to work together. In particular, staff going the extra mile to support Y11 and Y13 in exam preparation, whilst continuing to teach great lessons and capably look after the other year groups has been amazing.

Here are a couple of reminders and **an important update about how to pay** for your young person's school meals:

1. Parent Pay replacing WEDUC

As part of continually looking to improve our IT systems, we are making a change over the half-term break to how you pay for food in school.

We are moving to the **ParentPay** platform. All students have already provided their biometric credentials in school so that their accounts will be ready to use when they come back after half-term. Your child's current balance will transfer across from WEDUC to ParentPay automatically.

Following lunch today we have disabled the option to add funds to your child(s) account in WEDUC. By Wednesday 31st May you will receive an activation letter to your email address with simple instructions on how to add funds to your young person(s) account for food. If you have trouble setting up your account, or do not receive an activation letter by 1st June, please email finance@educationsouthwest.org.uk with your query. Please include KEV [Student's name] [year group] in the subject of the email and the team will get back to you as soon as possible.
