A-Level Art Induction Task 2023

We would like you to demonstrate potential in the four assessment objectives by which you will be judged. These are that candidates:

AO1 **Develop** their ideas through sustained and focused investigations informed by contextual

and other sources, demonstrating analytical and critical understanding.

AO2 **Experiment** with and select appropriate resources, media, materials, techniques and processes, reviewing and refining their ideas as their work develops.

AO3 **Record** in visual and/or other forms ideas, observations and insights relevant to their intentions, demonstrating an ability to reflect on their work and progress

AO4 **Present** a personal, informed and meaningful response demonstrating critical understanding, realising intentions and, where appropriate, making connections between visual, written, oral or other elements.

- 1. Find an example of a **famous** work of Art that provokes a strong response in you. Write about its context, the artist and what you think about it.
- 2. Make an observational drawing of an object, figure or place "related" to this work.
- 3. Develop 1. and 2. by making a further practical response to your chosen work. This could be a painting, sculpture, print or textiles piece.
- 4. Evaluate your response and explain how you have made connections to your chosen artist.
