Question	Answer
How do I apply to Kennicott Sixth Form	Please complete on-line application form on our college website.
What happens after I have sent my application form to Sixth form?	You will receive a written acknowledgement. In February offer letters are sent, these will be conditional pending obtainment of the required examination grades for your course choices. You will also receive an invite to attend 'taster days' in the summer term before joining us in September.
Do Sixth Form accept late applicants?	We ask that applications are sent by Jan 31 st in order to plan the time table and teaching requirements, however we do accept late applicants after this date.
Is it possible to come and visit the Sixth form centre?	Yes - please e-mail sixthform@kingedwardvi.org.uk to make an appointment.
Where can I find information about term dates and the school day timings?	This information can all be found on college the website at: www.kingedwardvi.org.uk under heading 'Information'.
When will I find out what tutor group I am in and meet my Tutor?	You will be given this information and meet with your tutor and fellow tutees in September.
When will I get a copy of my timetable?	New year 12 students will be given their timetable when joining us in September.
Where can I find information about the student canteen and food available?	At Kennicott the sixth form and Foundation Art students have their own canteen 'The Bothy', this is solely for their use. The Bothy will offer a selection of hot and cold breakfast and lunchtime snacks and meals between 8.15am and 2.15pm. Payment is cash (small change) and cashless via Parent Pay. Sorry we do not accept bank cards.
Will my free school meal entitlement continue at sixth form?	If you have received free school meals and have moved up from KEVICC or another Devon County Council school the entitlement will automatically continue. If you are joining from a private school or one from another county ie Torbay County Council you will need to apply to: https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals/devon
